Dear Mayor Gregor Robertson and Councillors,

Re: Motion for Increasing the Supply of Affordable Townhouses and Row Houses in the City of Vancouver, June 14, 2016

While we support solving the housing affordability crisis, we are OPPOSED to the above motion for the following reasons.

- 1. It is in conflict with current planning processes such as the Heritage Action Plan and Character House RS Zoning Review currently underway.
- 2. High land values are what makes housing unaffordable. Upzoning puts additional inflationary pressure on land values that just makes land even more expensive.
- 3. There is no single family zoning in the City of Vancouver. Most every house in RS zones can already have up to 3 units per lot: the main house, a secondary suite, and a laneway house. These must be for owner use or rental as mortgage helper. Demolition and replacement with new strata townhouses or row houses will result in a loss of affordable existing rentals.
- 4. New townhouses and row houses will likely be more expensive on a per square foot basis (for owners or renters) than existing housing that it may displace through demolition.
- Any new townhouse or row house zones should be only considered on a neighbourhood by neighbourhood basis and only where broadly supported by the local community as per the CVN Principles and Policies process. http://coalitionvan.org/principles-and-goals/

Please do not pass this motion. Instead, direct staff time towards completing the Heritage Action Plan and Character House RS Zoning Review currently in process, but taking far too long while demolitions continue.
